Team Selection Process

- Tryouts begin April 4 or as soon as Inverwood Opens
- \$5 tryout fee for every round played in tryouts
- Players pay Inverwood directly before they play each round
- A minimum of two 9-Hole rounds will be played; all tryouts based on weather
- 16/18 players will make the boys & girls V & JV
- Senior boys must make the Varsity
- All other grades make V or JV based on scores
- Coaches discretion may used in team decisions
- Boys on the Champ
- Girls on the Exec

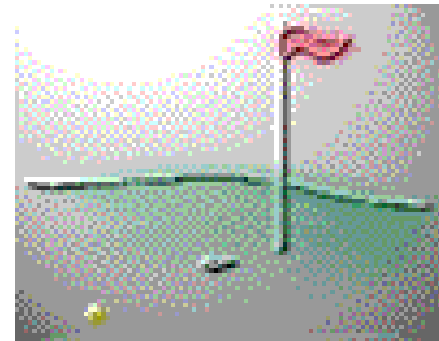

Early Season Practices

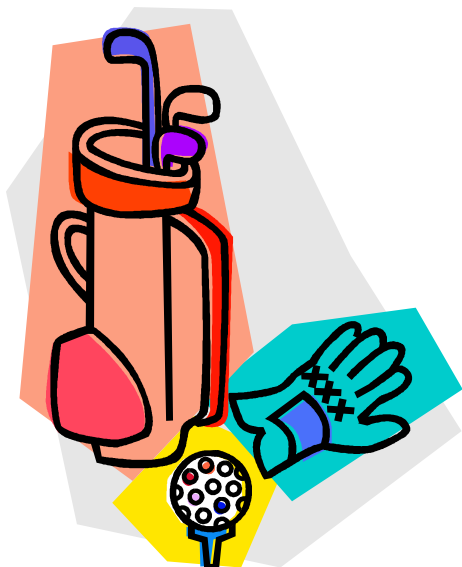
- No Practices During Spring Break

 - Golf balls



Forms

- Must complete and turn in athletic forms to Kim Madigan:
 - On or before March 21
 - Turn the forms into the HS office
 - Do not turn the forms into a coach
 - Must have a valid physical on file
 - If you played a sport or otherwise filled out forms this school year, you do NOT have to turn in forms
 - You do NOT have to pay the \$130 golf fee until after you make a team

Stuff We Must Cover

- Communication Process

- Lettering Criteria
 - Play in 5 Varsity matches
 - Be a Senior in the program
 - Coaches discretion
- Injuries
 - Report at once to a coach
 - Provide medical release
- Schedules
 - Visit website often

 - Weekly schedules will be given to players
 - Weather requires frequent changes and flexibility
